The health and wellness of all Senior Games participants, staff and volunteers remain our top priority. With that in mind, we have taken extra precautions as we plan the 2021 local games. Certain events will be held in person with modifications, while others will be self reporting.



Haywood County Senior Games is organized by Haywood County Recreation and Parks and is sanctioned through NC Senior Games. Those that qualify at their local games are invited to attend State Finals in the fall. And this year State Finals winners can qualify to represent North Carolina at the National Senior Games in Ft Lauderdale Florida in 2022.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to participate you must be 50 years of age or better on or before December 31, 2021 and be a resident of NC for 3 consecutive months.

AGE CATEGORIES

Your age category is determined by your age on December 31, 2021. Men & women compete in separate categories in the following five-year age increments: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94, 95-99, 100+. In doubles competition, partners compete in the age category of the younger partner.

REGISTRATION AND PARTICIPANT PROCESS

1. Participants must be registered online between April 5 through April 26. This includes all doubles partners and team members. Online registration is available at <https://torch.ncseniorgames.org>. Entry fee is \$15 and includes unlimited events and a 2021 Haywood County Senior Games shirt.

2. Sports participants complete your event following the specific guidelines for your sport. Although some activities will be completed by self reporting, each individual must agree to complete their activity with integrity and sportsmanship and to report their results honestly.

3. In-person sport participants will receive scheduled report times once registration is complete and report times are organized. (by email, if address provided).

4. Self reporting sports must turn in score or time by June 3.

5. **SilverArts:** submit your entry per the guidelines for your category. All entries must be received by May 17.

General Submission Guidelines

- Take photos in a well-lit area
- Take photos against a black, white, or otherwise neutral background
- "Front" photo should always include the WHOLE piece in the photo, and be as straight on as possible
- If your piece is framed, include the whole frame in the "front" photo of your piece
- If your piece is framed behind glass, try to reduce glare and reflection on the glass
- 3D entries: All Heritage Art categories, and Visual Art categories Mixed Media, and Sculpture can submit up to six (6) photos (including a front photo, a birds-eye-view photo, detail photo, bottom and photos of all sides if applicable)
- 2D entries: All Visual Art categories EXCEPT Mixed Media and Sculpture can submit up to three (3) photos (3 photos are recommended, including a front photo, side photo, and detail photo)
